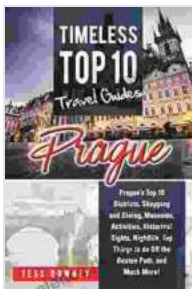

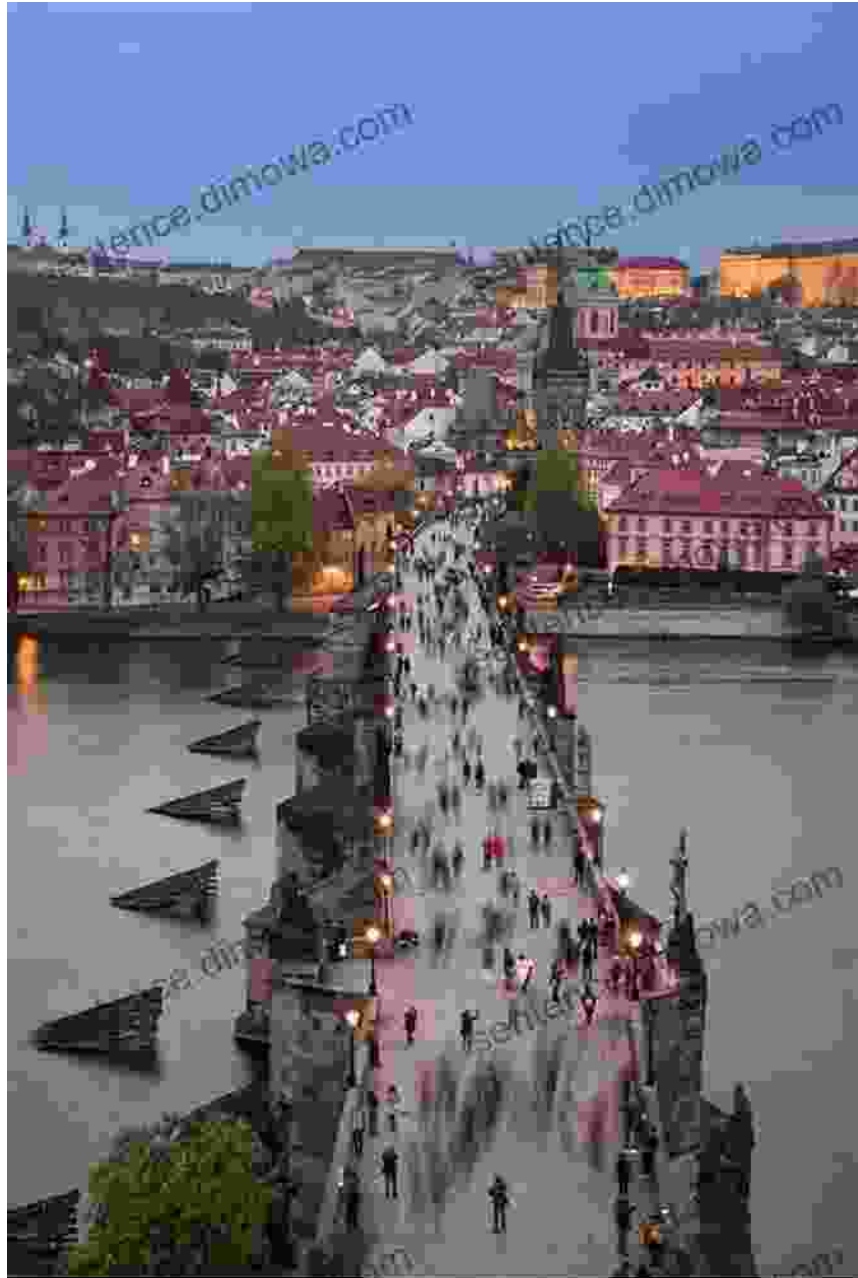
1. Old Town Square

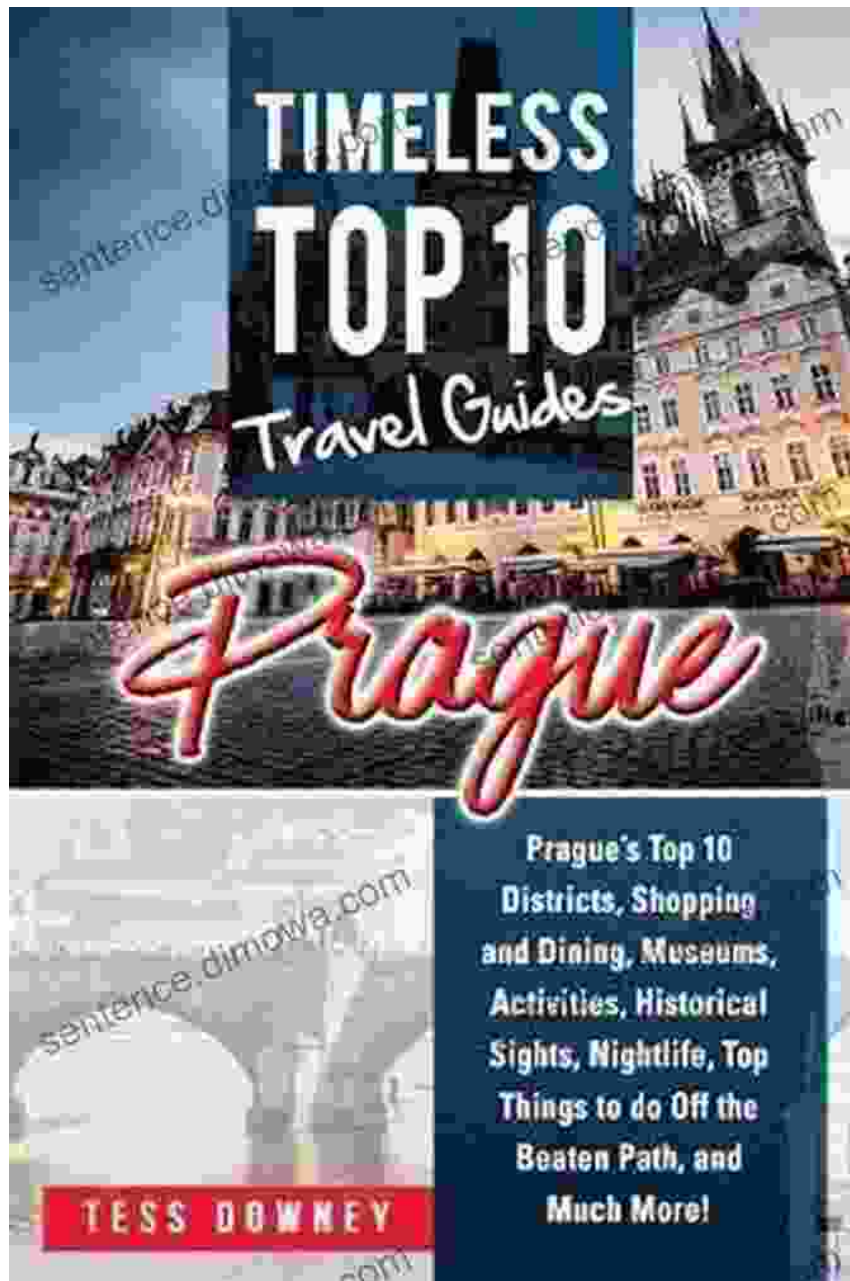
3. Prague Castle
