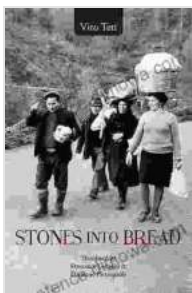


Stones into Bread: A Journey of Healing and Hope Through the Ashes of War

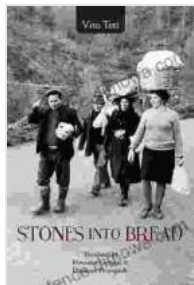

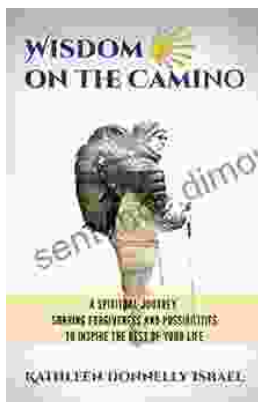
